COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

1. All entries and payments to be done online, <http://www.borc.co.za> - Entries. **NO** entries or payments will be accepted at the events. Self-scrutineering will be done online on the entry form. Documents need to be uploaded onto the entry form, payment confirmation, travel document (if needed), etc.
2. Entry, confirmation of payment, travel document (if needed), and WOMZA license should be kept together and brought to the event.
3. Everyone will be temperature tested at the front gate. Anyone in the vehicle displaying a temperature over 37.3°C, or presents with flu-like symptoms, or has indicated a high risk of exposure to the virus, will have to leave the premises, this includes all that are in the vehicle. The vehicle will not be allowed to enter.
4. Mask should be worn **at all times** except when on the motorcycle on the way to the start gate where a helmet is compulsory.
5. Race event envelopes will be collected at the gate with all documents, etc that's needed for the event.
6. The COVID-19 attendance register must be completed by all entering the event.
7. Sanitizers will be at the gate, toilets, and food areas. The Race Shop will be at all events and will be selling sanitizers and masks.
8. Toilets will be disinfected as often as practically possible. These surfaces will also be thoroughly cleaned after every use.
9. Practice physical distancing of 1.5 meters (preferably 2 meters) at all times from other groups of people not traveling with the competitor.
10. All communications are to be done with the Secretary of the meeting (Ansie Friedrichs – 082 465 1407)
11. Race results or disputes are to be dealt with the Secretary of the meeting (Ansie Friedrichs), within 15 minutes of them being sent out.
12. Any disputes are to be dealt with via WhatsApp with Ansie Friedrichs
13. No spectators are allowed at the event. Mechanics and crew members are NOT allowed on the track.
14. Pick-up marshals are not allowed to touch a competitor, they are only allowed to pick up the motorcycle and start the bike (Only for 50cc & 65cc competitors).
15. **NO ONE** IS ALLOWED TO PICK UP OR ASSIST ANYONE ON THE TRACK. PARA-MEDICS TO BE CONTACTED DIRECTLY.
16. Should a potential COVID-19 case be identified, areas that the person came into contact with will be isolated.
